Northern Mat & Bridge Subcontractor Requirements:

- Comply with the Northern Mat & Bridge Subcontractor Management Plan, Northern Mat & Bridge HSE Program, Client rules and regulations and all Provincial, Local, and Federal Transportation Laws.
- Understand that it is a condition to be on the Northern Mat & Bridge LP contractor list to participate within the Comply Works program, carry the appropriate insurance, carrier profile, (if applicable), NSC, CVIP, CVOR, and WCB, where applicable
- All contractors are required to comply with the applicable Occupational Health and Safety Acts, Regulations and Codes in the required province or federal regulations when applicable. Subcontractors must ensure all employees being sent to a Northern Mat & Bridge location will complete the required orientations.
- All employees and contractors will carry with them at all times, all orientations, clearance cards and training certifications required by Northern Mat & Bridge LP and their clients, failure to do so could result in being refused access to site or being dismissed from the site.
- Subcontractors must agree to develop and maintain a comprehensive health, safety and environment program and further train all employees and contractors in the requirements of that program in order to attain or maintain SECOR or COR.
- All Subcontractors must have the appropriate vehicle configuration, have the ability to use 4 straps on each stack of mats, and the legislated tie downs for transporting heavy equipment, including loaders, panthers, snow cats, excavators, army trucks and bridges etc.
- We agree and understand that as a contractor we cannot hire a subcontractor for any purposes to work on a Northern Mat & Bridge site or NMB client site without the subcontractor participating in Comply Works and being on the NMB vendor list without written approval from the appropriate manager.
- We will ensure all employees and contractors working for Northern Mat and Bridge LP shall be fit for duty as per the relevant Northern Mat & Bridge LP Drug and Alcohol policy, Journey Management policy, Fatigue Management policy and Fit for Duty policy. All policies and procedures are readily available once subcontractors are connected on ComplyWorks.
- All load securement procedures under NSC shall be strictly adhered to, this will include cleaning off equipment, matting, bridges, and decks as required.

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- All incidents, near miss, positive observations and hazardous conditions will immediately be reported to the Onsite Supervisor, NMB Dispatch on call at 780-897-3718 and the NMB HSE on call at 780-518-0009, our employees and contractors shall cooperate with all investigators. The contractor agrees to conduct an internal investigation and share all required supporting documents upon request from Northern Mat and Bridge LP HSE Department upon request.
- All employees and contractors shall be wearing all required PPE at the time of site arrival, failure to do so could result in the employee or contractor being asked to leave site with no compensation. All employees and contractors will be wearing a CSA approved **side impact hard hat**, 6” high steel toed CSA approved safety boots, Hi-vis and Hi-impact gloves (or CSA approved gloves for the appropriate task), FR Nomex III coveralls, appropriate CSA approved safety glasses or over the glasses safety glasses, and hearing protection as defined by the client. Reflective vests should be available to all employees and contractors as they are required in addition to FR NOMEX III coveralls by some clients.
- We agree to submit to an onsite audit by the HSE department of Northern Mat and Bridge LP upon request.
